

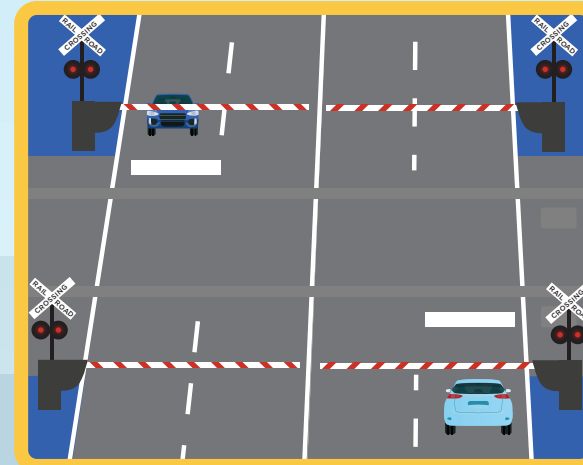
Taking measures to make the Cotton Belt “Silver Line”

DART is taking measures to ensure the Cotton Belt can travel safely and seamlessly throughout our region. That means implementing safety measures to keep our loved ones safe as trains pass through each of our communities.



IN NON-RESIDENTIAL AREAS, ENGINEERS SOUND HORNS FOR AT LEAST 15 SECONDS USING A SEQUENCE OF LONG AND SHORT SIGNALS BEFORE REACHING A PUBLIC CROSSING.



IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS, QUAD GATES PREVENT CARS FROM PASSING CROSSINGS, PROTECTING DRIVERS AND RIDERS AND ELIMINATING THE NEED TO USE THE HORN UNLESS THERE IS AN EMERGENCY OR UNSAFE SITUATION.



ADDITIONAL SIGNAGE, SAFETY LIGHTS, AND CROSSING GATES WILL KEEP PEDESTRIANS SAFE.



IN CROSSINGS WITHOUT QUAD GATES, NON-MOUNTABLE BARRIERS OR RAISED CURBS PREVENT CARS FROM DRIVING AROUND THE GATE.
